17 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.


18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

CONCLUSION


As you have just read, historical accounts explicitly state that Hitler did not believe in the Judeo-Christian notion of God despite his many references to God in his public speeches. Indeed, atheists are guilty of using the "[No True Scotsman](#)" argumentative fallacy in this case by trying to downplay atrocities committed by unbelievers like Hitler or Stalin. They throw the ball back in the court of believers and accuse them of being the ones to blame, when it was the skeptics themselves who committed these atrocities in the first place!
